'Living and Growing' videos

The series of programmes are fronted by three young presenters – one male and two female, and a well-known male children's television Doctor. They deal sensitively with the issues related to this subject. Children's own experiences are central, and children of various ages are interviewed throughout the series.

The programmes are honest in their presentation. Issues are discussed openly and clearly, and explanations are given in ways that are appropriate to this age range of children. Reassurance is given throughout the programmes that everyone grows and develops at different rates.


