Have you tried a LIVE event? Some of you have been given the opportunity to help us trial live events. We are sorry if they have been bumpy and you have had a few problems. On Sunday I almost threw my laptop out the window, as I tried to video examples of the work I was expecting for my Geography lesson. Did you get frustrated with your ICT? If you are one of the many students that despite training have struggled to remember their email address and password into Microsoft Teams, please be aware that you can access another way. We will send you a link to join via SMHW as well as an email, BUT you join as a 'guest', so you need to identify yourself by your name and class, before we can admit you into the lesson.

Have you tried a LIVE chat? These are meetings with your teacher and class and is an opportunity to share problems and concerns about the work and get immediate help. We think this might be a quicker way to get help rather than posting a comment and waiting for us to reply, which can take time. So if you get an invite, please give it a try.

What about video lessons? A number of Parents are telling us that you all like the video lesson, because you can replay the explanation of what to do. Many staff are now using videos to help you understand what you need to do. BUT DON'T stop reading the guide to your lesson, you can't learn without it!

How can you find out if a teacher is offering LIVE lessons, Chats or Video support? We will post the title of the work on SMHW, whether it is LIVE lesson, LIVE chat or a VIDEO is part of the work send you. We will also provide a timetable of the trials taking place. You can find a copy on the front page of our website www.edwinstree.herts.sch.uk but we hope to provide a concreate timetable by next week

Microsoft Teams Live Lessons – Student Protocols

This is a guide to help student, teacher and parent stay safe and successful when sharing Live Lessons and or Live Chats. It is essential that we work together to follow these guidelines.

- The best way to join Teams is by using your school email account via Office 365. If you have forgotten the password, you can join as a 'guest' while we work to reset it
- To join as a 'guest' the teacher will send students an invite via SMHW, you can click on a link to the meeting. If you join as a 'guest' to enter you will need to put your full name and your class when you are asked to identify yourself. For example Jo Gant 8E
- Make sure you only join the lesson and or COWO at the allotted time.
- Be patient, at the moment we have to let you through a lobby, so it takes us a minute as we are not practiced at this!
- Please make sure you are on 'mute', unless asked to unmute by the teacher. This stops feedback and helps the flow of the lesson.
- Please make sure that you are dressed appropriately to be seen on the screen, particularly in LIVE chats in LIVE lessons we may ask you to keep your cameras off, until we get confident.
- Students can ask questions by using the 'Raise Hand' function or typing the question in the chat box
- Please avoid any form of recording or photo of the session. The session will be recorded for safeguarding purposes.
- If you are unable to follow the protocols you will be removed from the session. We will contact home to discuss with your parents how we can help you to follow these simple guidelines
