How do I report a child absent?

Please remember to inform us **every day** that your child is absent from school. Please use the dedicated email address: <u>attendance@edwinstree.herts.sch.uk</u> or you can leave a phone message after 8:30am. Please do not use Parentmail, School Gateway or any other email addresses, as these are not routinely monitored. Thank you for your co-operation.

What happens if my child or a family member tests positive for Covid-19?

How can I make communication via Parentmail easier?

As a school, we use Parentmail to communicate with you. In order to make the system more efficient, we recommend that you download the IRIS Parentmail app from the app store. This will ensure all school communication is in one place, so you do not miss any important messages or updates.

Who should you contact if you have a worry or concern?

The tutor is the first port of call for any worry or concern, nothing is too small to ask. However, teaching staff do not have access to a phone during the school day and we recommend you email. If you email the Admin team, please indicate your child's name and year group. We will then pass this onto the tutor and they are the first port of call for any problem. If you have a concern about learning or a more serious problem, we would recommend you contact your child's Head of Year:

Can my child bring a mobile phone into school?

Yes, but please be aware that in line with our Mobile Phone Agreement, the school will not accept liability for a lost or damaged mobile phone and actively encourages parents to purchase a low cost device. Students will be required to hand their phones in at the start of the day and collect at the end. We encourage students to use our guest Wi-Fi when in school, as it has strong safety settings. Please be aware no phone is necessary for learning in school. Mobile Phone Agreement to follow.

Sometimes, by accident, we encounter an inappropriate word and if we do, we will always address it, explain it is inappropriate and highlight the risks when researching the internet.

Year 8 Visiting Freman in lieu of Open Evening

This year we will not be holding a traditional Open Evening but instead all Year 8 students will have a tour of the college during the working day. While our initial motivation was based on concerns regarding Covid, we actually think this will be a better experience for all concerned.

Arrangements for students

On **Thursday 23rd September**, all Year 8 students from Edwinstree will visit Freman for a tour of the college in small groups with one of our prefects. I will meet with them briefly in a socially distanced assembly before the prefects show them around to see lessons taking place in a variety of subjects and facilities such as the Sports Hall and the Canteen. Their visit will end with a question and answer session to address any queries they might have.

Arrangements for parents

In addition, for parents who do not have older children with us and have not yet visited Freman, we are offering optional tours of the college during the working day. Please follow this <u>link</u> to let us know if you would like a tour and we will get back to you with a date and time.

In order to keep the numbers on tours manageable we are limiting this to one parent per student. (Students will not be expected to come with their parent as they will already have had a tour.)

As this gives students and any parents who wish to do so the opportunity to see the college in action on a normal day, we think this is likely to be a more useful and interesting experience than a regular Open Evening.
