What is the latest update regarding COVID?

As of Thursday, we have 4 positive COVID cases across all year groups. Please be aware of the three symptoms and if your child develops a temperature, cough or loss of taste and smell, please seek a PCR test. If your child presents as unwell, please be cautious. Please continue to test over the half term and log your results on the Government website Thank you.

What happens if my child or a family member tests positive for Covid-19?

Please do not send notifications of absence to the admin email, Parentmail or via School Gateway as these are not routinely checked early in the morning and may result in unnecessary phone calls home. Are we still a cluster? We were advised on Friday, that now cases have reduced, we are no longer a cluster. This means that we will can release some of the year group bubble restrictions such as toilets, break and lunchtimes. However, as cases could increase during half term, we will make the changes two weeks after half term.

What is the school toilet situation?

Thank you to handful of Year 6 parents who have alerted us to their concerns regarding the toilets shared by both boys and girls due to year group bubbles. We are currently looking into this and will find a solution. In the meantime, any student who is worried, please let us know and they will be able to use the visitor's toilet.

What educational visits or trips will be planned this year?

Attached is the list of the 15 things each year group voted that they would like to do this year and we plan to make sure we achieve as many of these as possible. We are focusing on providing opportunities for visits that are predominantly local, as we would be disappointed if visits were cancelled due to COVID outbreaks. Prior to COVID, residential visits in Y6 and Y8 were organised at a cost of £300 - £400 and over a third of students were unable to take part. We want to ensure that what we offer is accessible to as many students as possible. The event will run from 4pm to 6pm and is an informal opportunity for you to see the school, classrooms and have a chat with your child's teachers about learning in lessons. You do not need to book an appointment. If cases of Covid rise or

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Government advice changes, we may need to move this online at short notice. This would involve booking times with subject teachers, but we will contact you if this should happen.

How will lunchtimes change after half term?

We are pleased to confirm that the canteen will return to more a normal operation. Year 5 & Year 6 will be first sitting in the hall while Year 7 and Year 8 go out to play, Year 7 & Year 8 will be second sitting. Students will queue in year groups and eat in the hall, packed lunches (if they chose, may like to go outside). After Christmas, we will rotate the sittings.
