What is the latest COVID update?

Last night, we finally received notification from Public Health that we are no longer an Outbreak school. The one exception is 6D currently have two cases. Until posting negative results, 6D will be asked to eat their lunch in their classroom rather than the hall. We can now make the following changes:

- Students are no longer required to wear masks, but can continue to if they wish. This includes no masks on public transport.
- We can release segregation of students so that they can eat lunch together in the hall, this will begin next week.
- Students no longer required to complete mandatory testing twice a week.
- Staff or students who test positive for Covid will no longer be legally required to self-isolate but are still advised to stay at home and avoid contact with others for at least five full days.
- Routine contact tracing will end, so fully vaccinated close contacts and those under 18 will no longer be legally required to test daily for seven days

What measures continue?

Schools continue to be advised to mitigate against the likelihood of students and staff getting COVID by making sure that we promote:

- Good hygiene for everyone with a focus on hand washing and respiratory hygiene – ‘catch it and bin it!’
- Maintain appropriate cleaning regimes
- Keep occupied spaces well ventilated
- Continue to follow all Public Health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases.

After the 24th February can COVID measures be stepped up?

Yes. If our numbers were to increase we would be expected to consult with Public Health and all measures can revert to an Outbreak plan level. ie masks return.

Have the children been told about the changes?

Yes, students were informed today, but as it was a busy Fullness Day, we will take them through the changes again on Monday morning.
