### Satchel One – which supports our homework on line – information and changes update:

#### Satchel One email verification

To improve security and support GDPR practices, Satchel One have implemented an email verification system for parent accounts. The majority of parents have completed this process but for those that remain unverified you will receive an email from <a href="mailto:noreply@teamsatchel.com">noreply@teamsatchel.com</a> informing you that your parent account will be deactivated. Please note that this is a genuine communication.

### What do I do if I missed the deadline and my parent account is deactivated?

In order to recover your account, you need to obtain a current Parent PIN Code and complete the sign-up process again. You do not need to contact the school to get a new PIN code, a new one can be accessed independently via your child's Satchel One account by following the steps below:

#### Obtaining a Parent Code

Obtaining a Parent Code will allow you to create a new parent / guardian account or recover an existing account you have lost access to.

Please follow the guidance below to obtain an up to date Parent Code (please note that Parent Codes expire 3 months after being generated).

#### Via the mobile app

You can access your Parent Code from your child's account on the mobile app. To do this, go to Settings > Parent Code.

## Buntingford Swimming Club






#### Buntingford Swimming Club - Calling all swimmers who have passed Swim England Learn to Swim Framework Stage 7.

We have been running as a voluntary coaching club since 1976 at Freman swimming pool and have seen our numbers rise and fall across the years as swimming and the support for the sport has gone in and out of fashion. Funding for swimming lessons received a significant boost after the 2012 Olympics but as you will be aware that has long since been cut and numbers have dropped to an all-time low. Many schools are no longer able to offer swimming lessons and with Covid and a cost of living crisis many small teaching clubs are closing and young swimmers are not being given the opportunity to develop further. The benefits of swimming need no explanation and it's a key life skill every child should experience.

We are doing all we can to keep the club financially viable and keep things ticking over and we desperately need new members in order for this to happen. We've taken the decision to offer 6 weeks free swimming to any newcomer who wants to give us a try. We are a coaching club and not a teaching club so there is a minimum standard of skill level required.
