# What is the impact of increasing numbers of COVID cases?

Please note that COVID cases are rising rapidly in the community and we now have 3 members of staff out. A local school closed 2 year groups this week in order to staff their school. While we do not wish to do this, it will again be a potential option as more schools begin to suffer and agency staff are in short supply. Our current guidance still requires staff to be out for 5 days from test and or symptoms.

### Sports Day - Tuesday 12th of July

After missing out over the past couple of years on Sports Day as we know it, the PE department are excited to bring this year's back in all its former glory!

In the morning students will take part in a rotation of activities that are designed to involve and engage all students, although no one will be forced to participate only encouraged.

We ask that parents arrive from 12:30pm, when our round robin activities finish, in order to be ready for our picnic lunch on the field which starts from 12:45pm. You are welcome to bring small tents and or gazebo's if it is hot and a picnic lunch to share with your child and or friends. Please enter the school through reception where we will ask you to sign in.

Students will then return to their form rooms to collect belongings before being dismissed at 3:05pm. # My child finds sports day a challenge – how will you support them?

Please reassure them, no one is forced to participate – if they are very vulnerable there will be an alternate space for children with learning set up. Encourage them to come in as no one ever regrets this decision. We will also be providing activities based around supporting sports day with photography, journalists, scorers etc. So that our most vulnerable can participate in a way that works for them.

### **Year 6 Wicked Theatre Trip Wednesday of 13<sup>th</sup> July** Your child will need to bring with them:

- Comfortable clothes and shoes.
- Home packed lunch
- A small snack and drink (no glass bottles or sweets)
- A small backpack [to be carried throughout the day]
- Any medication [including travel sickness tablets] clearly labelled with their name to be handed to the office prior to the visit.

On the day of the visit, students need to arrive at school by 8:40am for am lessons. There will be an early lunch and Students will need to bring a home packed lunch (a cold option will be available to book via School Grid for Free School Meal students). We plan to leave the school at 12:15pm and arrive back at Edwinstree for approximately 7:20-7:30pm. Alternative travel arrangements need to be made for those who use school transport.

We are in the process of revitalising our libraries in preparation for September. Please would you ensure that all Edwinstree books are returned, particularly Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief, Trash, Skellig and Hunger Games. We have had hardly any returned despite our reminders. Students have also been reminded via SMHW. To support reading in school for the remainder of the year, please ensure your child has a book of their own in school to read

#### What Summer school provisions are available?

In our reception we have a variety of leaflets on the different private provision and clubs available. If you are PP, Mrs Marler is in touch to make sure you are aware of funded placements and how to get support with free school meals through the Summer. We will also be contacting PP parents about support for making sure that students keep their basic maths and English at the correct standard in the Summer – with teachers offering small tuition sessions from the 3<sup>rd</sup> to the 16<sup>th</sup> of September. These will be by invitation only.

Our vulnerable and SEND students will be phoned in the last two weeks of the holiday and offered visits to settle them into their new timetable and to meet familiar staff. If we have not talked to you about this and you think you need the service please email the Learning Zone.

When will my child know their tutor and their class? Only year 7 classes are changing and students and parents will be informed of the change at the end of term in their reports. All students voices have been listened to. If your child is SEND and or vulnerable the Learning Zone team will be prepping them in the last week of term.

#### How can we make parental payments from September?

Due to closures of local banks, we are finding it increasingly difficult to pay money into our school bank. With effect from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022 Edwinstree will become a cashless school. Payments will be requested via school gateway only.
