## **PE Lessons – All Years**

All classes will need a mouthguard, black football socks, shin pads and football boots in order to safely participate in hockey, football and rugby lessons.

### How do we support your child's wellbeing?

As part of this strategy your students will be introduced and guided each morning on how to support their well being and mental health. We would like to introduce you to what we do and how we do this. We will be setting up a 30-minute session on mental health strategies and how you might support these at home, more details to follow next week.

## When will my child have home learning?

The full home learning timetable will start WB Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September. The Timetable will be shared in next week's newsletter. In summary, KS2 will receive Maths, English, French and DT. KS3 will receive homework from each subject but the foundation subjects will be set every two weeks.

## What about trips and enrichment?

We are extremely aware of the cost of living crisis and the impact this is having on all of us. We are therefore very mindful about the trips and activities we offer to students and the costs that will be incurred by you. We also want to ensure that as many students as possible are able to attend, below is a link to a questionnaire that we send out each year to parents, asking you to anonymously help to guide us in how much a trip should cost, and/or our enrichment activities i.e. disco's. Last vear the most common response was that trips needed to be around the  $\pounds 25 - 30$  cost. and discos  $\pounds 5$  max. Our residential takes place for Year 7 in September and parents guided us that a maximum of £250 with plenty of time to pay was important. We will listen again this year as to what Year 6 can afford. We would really appreciate you taking the time to complete this and help us to make sure we are supporting you. ## Year 8 French

Students had a positive start this week. As part of their curriculum we have introduced the opportunity for students to attend Freman for half of their year 8 French course. Ms Theroulde will be teaching one topic and Mrs Smith from Freman the other. This benefits the students as they get used to attending Freman and are familiar with some of the staff, it goes a long way to calming any transition nerves, and helps to get them ready and excited about next year. The first two groups to go up until the end of January are 8C and 8D. A member of staff registers them out and walks them up to site and another returns them.

## **Music France Tour**

Below is a unique opportunity that we have been offered by Freman which is an expensive tour, but the Head of Music felt that the opportunity was too great not to offer to you.

We are excited to announce that we are going on a joint tour with Freman College to France. This will be in the first week on the summer holidays 2024 and will include concerts and some super fun activities during the day! There are still a lot of details to iron out, but we hope to stay in a Chateau (A French castle) and it will either be full or half board. We expect it to cost around £500 per student, but we are in the early stages, so will hope to confirm the price and give more details around the October half term when we send out the 'register your interest' sheet. There will only be 50 spaces and, if oversubscribed, we will do a random selection, making sure we cover both choir and orchestra. Therefore, to be in with the best chance of a space, we recommend being in both the music extra-curriculars that we are offering this year. Please see flyer attached.

## What is The Happy After-School Club?

Is a weekly hour-long session, involving games, movement, mindfulness and relaxation. It gives students the opportunity to offload any stresses from the week and let go of difficult emotions, whilst learning valuable techniques to self-regulate and feel calm. Sessions involve positive mindset activities to build confidence and self-esteem, along with breathing techniques, gentle stretches and end with a guided meditation.
