### Maths

Home Learning will consist of two elements, practise of the current learning plus a puzzle which will be appropriate to the student's age and year group. These will be provided on one sheet of paper as a hard copy. The home learning will be set each week, and the expectation is that the students bring in the completed hard copy to discuss during the following week's lesson. Students will be provided with an exercise book to stick their home learning into. They will not need to access 'Satchel One' to complete the home learning, although copies will be added here.

This is a change to the previous structure of home learning, in response to parental feedback.

Year 6 will complete the same home learning until they receive their SATs Practice Book which will replace the current home learning.

### English

In English across both KS2 and KS3, students will be set one Reading and one Spelling Home Learning a week. Students in Years 6,7 and 8 will also be set a GPS Home Learning. This is in addition to the 20 minutes of reading per night we ask students to complete.

## **French**

KS2: To support literacy Year 5 and Year 6 students will be given to read a text linked to French history, culture, geography etc.. Both the text and questions will be in English.

KS3: Year 7 and 8 students will be set a list of vocabulary to learn and tested weekly. The list will be given to them physically as well as on Satchel one. I would also encourage our students to practice the weekly vocabulary test on Quizlet.

All Years: There will regular whole school competitions linked to French culture.

## **Science**

In all year groups, Science will be set weekly for each class and will consist of one piece of work that at KS2 should take no longer than 20 minutes and at KS3 may take but should not exceed 30 minutes. These will be set on Satchel One and will consist of key word learning, spellings, consolidation of learning and, in some cases pre-learning.

## **Food**

If your child is cooking, recipes will be given out a week before they are due to cook.

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Please note that when a teacher feels it is appropriate, they may use 'Satchel One' to send a reminder to parents and students if the home learning has not been received. Please have a conversation with your child and support them with any difficulties they are having. Supporting them is also encouraging them to speak to the class teacher for any extra guidance they may need.
