

MAZE COMPETITION

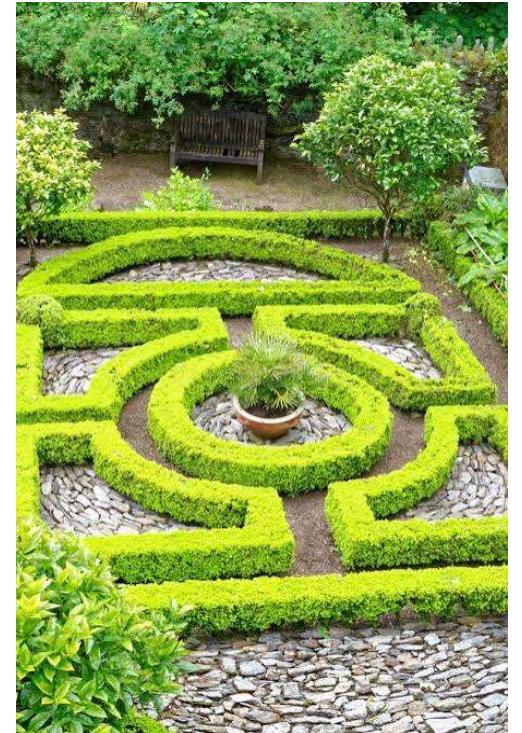
Edwinstree Middle School is lucky enough to be working in partnership with the Woodland Trust to design and create a working maze on the school field.

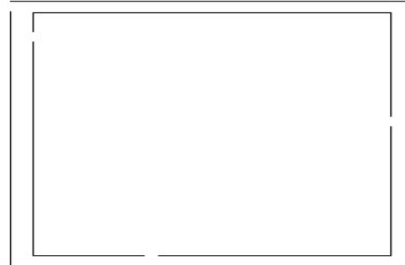

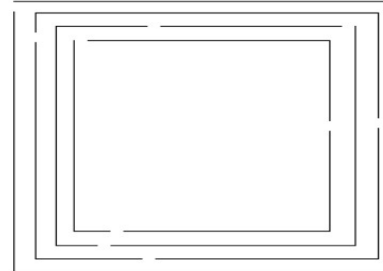
Finding it tricky to start? Follow this step by step guide:



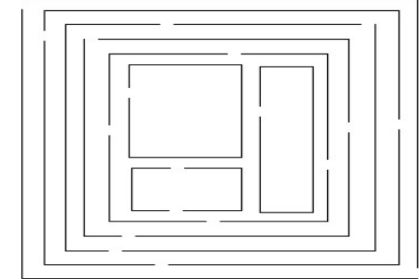
Step 1
Draw a rectangle. Erase two holes in it. I put mine in the corners as shown in the picture. This will be your entrance and exit.



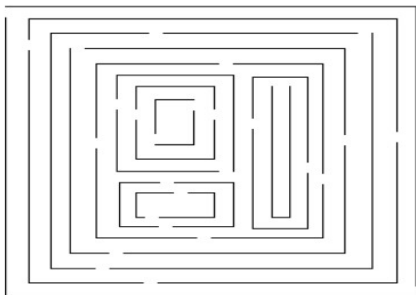
Step 2
Draw another rectangle inside the first square. Erase more holes in that square. I made 3 holes in mine.



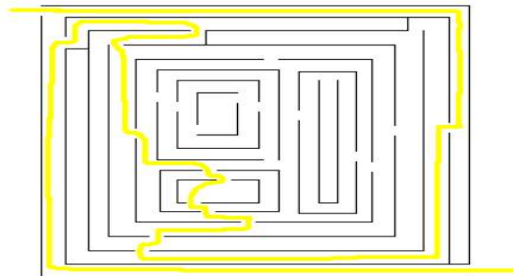
Step 3
Draw more and more rectangles inside each other. Yours should look pretty close to mine, other than the holes.



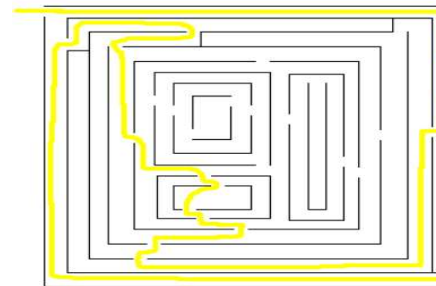
Step 4
Now you can draw different shapes inside that rectangle.. Erase holes in them too.



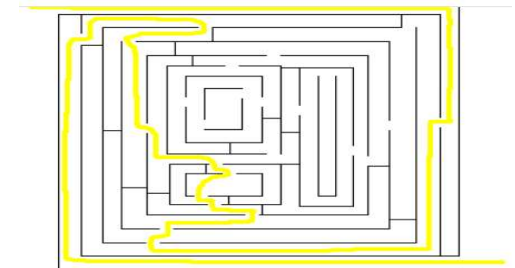
Step 5
Fill those in with squares and/or rectangles Erase holes in those too.



Step 6
Figure out where you want the only way through the maze to be. I highlighted mine.



Step 7
Now start drawing lines to close off paths other than the way through.



Step 8
Finish drawing lines. You may have had to erase some more holes to make the maze more confusing. Make sure there are no other ways through the maze. If there are, close it off with a line. NOW ADD COLOUR and any special features too.
