Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) Policy and 2024 Lesson Curriculum

We wanted to make all Parent/Carers aware of the Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) lessons for 2024. We will be sharing our updated draft RSE policy for you to read after half term. The Department for education asks us to consult with parents and the wider community in terms of this policy. Amongst other things the policy does is include what lessons we define as "sex education" and your rights to withdraw your child. Please also note that this year we are considering changes in what time of year we deliver these and will confirm beforehand in the weekly school newsletter, please keep an eye open for this.

Lesson topics that we intend to cover as part of our RSE unit are on the table to follow. We purposely adapt these lessons as best as we can to meet the needs of our students as well as meeting government requirements. We take a great deal of advice from the PSHE Association, who are the national body for PSHE education.

This year we have again decided to primarily base our RSE lessons on those supplied by the PSHE Association with some additions and changes. This helps to ensure that lessons are appropriate and cover the necessary content.

Flu Vaccination Catch up Session
