How to support yours, and your child's mental health?

We are looking forward to two full weeks at school. Despite the loveliness of a Bank Holiday, we have seen this week how unsettling the extra breaks have been for students, and we once again notice that our students are higher than high, or lower than low when change arrives in school. This is repeated across the country in schools. Students give a snap shot of the communities' mental health. Post pandemic and with such huge hikes in the cost of living, all public services have noticed a significant decline in the mental health of their own teams and the community they work in.

How does this play out in school?

We will see more unregulated behaviour from our students, some parents are quicker to anger and will shoot aggressive and threatening emails and or phone calls. Our admin team will receive at least two of this type of anxiety related anger a day.

How can we help?

There is no quick fix, but understanding stress, and anxiety, noticing the symptoms, and then sharing and building strategies to deal with them is vital to helping us all cope in a very difficult world.

Would you like to attend a session to hear how the school supports your child, what mental health strategies we give them, and how this has not only helped our students but also ourselves? We will be running two after school sessions from 5pm to 6pm, dates to be confirmed. We would like to know whether you would like these sessions in person or would prefer online. Online limits the numbers to 100. But we will listen to your voice.
