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# Who are the team of people that work with SEND students?

We no longer use one SENCO to lead all the SEND students within the school, as the number of SEND students has increased by 100% in the last two years. This is not unusual for a mainstream school post COVID. We now have a team of staff who lead the SEND support within the school. Here they are, with the areas they support in:

- Ms Campany is our SENCO who with Mrs Carter leads on the EHCP reviews and writing. She is also our dyslexic Lead.
- Mrs Carter works with year 5 transition SEND students and is our Autism Lead.
- Mrs Arnold leads the pupil power unit which supports students who struggle to learn without an additional adult to supervise.
- Mrs Harris is our Mental Health team, and she Leads the Wellbeing Hub that support all students who are struggling with their mental health for a variety of reasons.
- Mrs Surrey works alongside Mrs Harris to support in the Wellbeing Hub.
- Mrs Bailey supports students most at risk of school avoidance. Her base is the Sunrise room.

If you wish to contact the SEND team — use the SENCO email, depending on the need this will be distributed to one of the SEND team above. <a href="mailto:senco@edwinstree.herts.sch.uk">senco@edwinstree.herts.sch.uk</a>. By the end of this month those students and parents on the register will receive information on who their link SEND contact is from the team above, and how and when we will formally communicate with them about their child's needs, provision and wellbeing.

# What have your children been thinking about in COWO?

In COWO we have been considering what it means to be a Church of England school.

We have been reminding and exploring the bible text, John 15:4:11.

Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.

### What is Open evening?

# How can you support your child's wellbeing?

Please can we remind Parent/Carers that mobile phones are not necessary in school. If your child does have one, please can we ask that wherever possible you make sure that phones are not stored in rooms overnight. We repeatedly come across online issues occurring in the early hours of the morning.

Could we also ask that you monitor closely any involvement your child has with WhatsApp and Snapchat as these are the most likely places for peer-on-peer abuse to take place. We would always recommend that chat groups, etc are set up with only their closest friends.
