What is the difference between a Core and a Foundation Parents evening?

Core evenings are online for Maths, English and Science. Foundation evenings are more informal events, where you can arrive at the school any time between 5 pm and 7pm to review your child's foundation books and speak to the teachers. There is no formal appointment time for this event. Foundation subjects are those in the curriculum that are not English, Maths or Science. Our Chair of Governors will be available to speak to you if you wish, there is also an opportunity to scan our QR code to download a questionnaire and give us feedback on the school and where we can make further improvements.

Why are there so many supply teachers in the school and what are the plans for post Easter, will this continue?

We are experiencing a high level of staff with medium to long term illness, which has resulted in a number of supply teachers. We have been working hard to remedy the situation when a member of staff is due to be absent for a considerable period of time. Solutions post Easter are as followed:

- We have secured a strong and experienced teacher Miss Nichols to lead the classes for Mrs Hayes, and she will be here for the rest of the year. Mrs Mayne our Deputy for Teaching and Learning has been working with her this term to ensure that the schemes of work are being followed, and for year 6, support is in place for their progress towards the SATs.
- Miss Bull's maternity cover is Mrs Mayne who will be with the Year 6 classes until the end of the year.
- Year 7 English classes will be taken by Mrs Russell who is secondary trained former Head of English.
- Mr McCarthy is planning to return post Easter.

As a Christian school we recognise the unique and wonderful in everyone. As a community we support one another to flourish and live life in all its fullness.

- Ms Sanders Science lessons are being covered by a Specialist Science teacher Mr Grinyai and this will continue for the next two weeks and post half term.
- Mr Wainwright-Meekins we are expecting a mediumterm absence – we are looking to source a long-term supply for post Easter. Miss Nichols will be 7C Form Tutor
- Mrs Gant the Head returns from 3 weeks absence due to Long Covid, from next week.

Is so much ill health normal in a school the size of Edwinstree ? Pre COVID no, post COVID we have seen an increase in the level of Medium to Long ill health. But this term has been particularly challenging.

What changes are there to clubs next week? Please be aware that due to staff absence we are unable to deliver the following clubs next week: Wednesday – KS3 Football Thursday – KS2 Football

Maths Home Learning club with Mrs Earnshaw will continue to run up until the end of the term, however for <u>next week only</u> this will take place on Thursday 21^{st} and not Wednesday 20^{th} .

Will there be enrichment clubs in the last week of term and when can I sign my child up for post Easter?

Please be aware that we will be closing the enrichment clubs a week early due to staff shortage. At the start of next term there will be a two-week window to sign up for new clubs before they start on Monday 29th April.

PE Kits next week

On days that students have PE we are asking them to come into school wearing their PE kit. This will help teachers covering PE lessons. We would like to continue this plan until the end of term. Thank you

Please remember Students will need to bring additional shoes if they have Food and Nutrition, Wood Tech or Science as they are not allowed to enter the classrooms with material trainers for safety reasons.

What are the plans for the Easter services this year?
