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## SATs exam request for volunteers

A plea for help and support during the mock SATs week and the actual SATs week.

Like all schools nationally, we have seen a significant growth in children with Special Educational Need. So much so that we are looking to support 36 children with extra time and/or reading support for their SATs exam.

**Can you help us?** We have relied on volunteers in the past who are willing to give up a Monday to Thursday morning to come and sit in a room with our most vulnerable children and a member of staff, as the ratio of adults to children increases under these conditions for the exams.

We have 10 volunteers currently but are short another 10. We don't have enough staff to cover this and keep the remainder of the school running. To bring in supply for the week at £250 a day, would be a huge hit on an already over stretched budget.

## Do you know of a family member?

Would you be willing to support? It requires a commitment from 8.45am to 11.30am from Monday to Thursday during the weeks of 3-6<sup>th</sup> February and 12<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> May. **Even if you are unable to commit to the full week,** any help would be so gratefully received.

# What are the different type of parents' evenings that we host?

## Academic reviews:

These are consultation evenings with the Core teachers of English, Maths and Science. They take place online during the winter. Teachers will have the students' books there for you to review. We are looking forward to meeting you and discussing your child's progress.

## Foundation Evenings:

These are evenings where you can come into school with your child to meet the teachers of the subjects that are not core, we will also leave out your child's English, Maths and Science books in their tutor room, in order for you to look at their progress over the first term. We have a Governor representative and the Head of Year at the evening or an SLT member for any questions and/or concerns to be shared, so we can address these swiftly. You are not required to book a slot, please come to school with your child between 5-7pm.

## What is happening on the 31<sup>st</sup> of January?

The Church of England asks us to promote the virtue of Courageous advocacy, the ability to see a wrong, feel passionate about an issue and/or make a change. We support students to understand that no change is too small and we can all make differences to causes and concerns.

## Year 6 Mock SATs week – 3rd to 6th February

This is an opportunity for staff and students to have a run through before they take their exams in May. The practice tests take place from Monday to Thursday during periods 1 & 2, students will then continue with their normal timetable for the rest of the day.

Please ask your child to arrive at school at 8.30am, we will provide your child with a small snack. Please ensure that your child has plenty of rest the night before and goes to bed at a reasonable time.

### Year 6 Cambridge Science Centre Visits

We are delighted to be able to offer Year 6 the opportunity to visit Cambridge Science Centre. This educational visit will take place on the following dates: 6A & 6B on the 5th of March 2025 6C & 6D on the 6th of March 2025.

Your child will need to bring with them:

- Full school uniform with comfortable shoes or trainers.
- A snack and water bottle [no glass bottles please]
- A small backpack [to be carried throughout the day]
- Any medication [including travel sickness tablets] clearly labelled with their name, to be handed to the office by 28th February 2025

The cost of this visit will be £19.90 per student, which includes coach hire, parking and entrance. This is a voluntary contribution, however if we do not have enough to cover the visit then it will not be able to go ahead. Payment is nonrefundable unless due to exceptional circumstances your child is not able to attend. Payment can be made via the school Gateway. Payment and consent form should be completed by Friday 21st February 2025.
