How can you help to keep our children safe and well?

Please would you ensure you park safely when collecting your child after school. There are clear lines marked on the road and signs nearby indicating a no waiting zone. Please do not park, wait, or drop off on the zig zags either side of the school gates.

What changes are we proposing after the SEND consultation, regarding parents' communication last term?

The Wellbeing Hub, the Sunrise room and Pupil Power unit will be offering our most vulnerable children 3 days, during the year where parents are able to attend a meeting during the school day to discuss their child's SEND needs and set a plan for the next half term. This was requested in consultation with SEND parents and we are looking to support it.

The Wellbeing Hub will host between 2pm until 6pm. The first date for these consultation days will be Tuesday 22nd October. As a parent of a child who has an ECHP and/or is assigned to any of these rooms, we will be contacting you individually to invite you to your first session.

When and What is Open evening, and how does it involve my child?

Next week we will be asking children to help us host our annual Open Evening where the school comes together, and we invite prospective parents to view the school. Please note, current parents are welcome too. To help us showcase the school, we ask for volunteer students to work in the different departments for the night and/or tour prospective parents. Your child will have a chance to sign up next week. We will then send you a letter to confirm that they wish to attend, and a link for you to sign them up. Our Open Evening takes place on the 10th of October from 6.15 pm till 8 pm.

Satchel One dashboard

You may have noticed that your child's dashboard on Satchel One currently reads as having no positive points (or very few if some were added today).

We have updated our internal systems to increase the different types of merits we can give, to align with the school's vision and values and to give you more information about why the merit was given. This has had an impact on what is currently being displayed on the Satchel One dashboard, although you can still see the merits and reason in the 'points breakdown'.

We do have internal records of the merits your child has received; we will make sure that the merit charts in the tutor rooms are updated to reflect their up-to-date totals. We will also look for a different solution if the dashboard doesn't reflect the points totals correctly in the coming days/weeks.

What are our Term dates?

We try hard to match our holiday dates to that of Freman, to support parents with children at both schools. We also try to offer an opportunity for an early start to the Summer break to capitalize on cheaper holiday prices. Safety in Practical Subjects

Please ensure you consider the safety requirements of footwear in the practical subjects. In order for pupils to be safe in Science, Food and Nutrition, and DT lessons they are required to wear hard topped, polishable shoes. This is to prevent them from being scalded by hot water, burnt by acid if dropped or injured from falling sharp objects. We have to plan for such events and ensure the safety of every child. Please support your child to take part in these practical subjects by ensuring their feet are safe. Here are some example shoes that will meet the needs of these subjects.
