New timings – September 2023

From September we will be increasing the length of the school day by five minutes, to comply with the Government's expectation that all mainstream, state-funded schools should provide a school week of at least 32.5 hours. Our new timings will be **8.40am to 3.10pm**.

How to get ready for next year?

Please remember we have a change to uniform occurring this year – with us moving away from ties and jumpers to logo sweatshirts. You can purchase the new sweatshirts and our PE tops from Price and Buckland. If you are a (next year) year 6,7 or 8 parent who is going to struggle to make the change to the sweatshirt top, in the first instance and/or you have perfectly good jumpers that need out-growing we will allow students in year 6,7 and 8 to wear jumpers in the first term until you are ready to buy the sweatshirts.

If you are choosing a black plain pair of trainers as your child's footwear, please make sure it has a hard surface top, in order to allow them to take part safely in Science experiments and Tech. These subjects are also keen to ensure that students avoid rings, hoop earrings and false and fake nails as these can cause extra risk and harm.

What equipment are we asking students to bring in to school with them next term?

Why are we asking students to bring in this equipment?

Firstly, during the pandemic, we moved to the school supplying students with basic equipment as a safety measure to prevent the spread of Covid. This has cost the school many thousands of pounds, which we simply can no longer budget for. Secondly, we have found that students who are prepared for lessons are also prepared for learning. As we begin to introduce our new ethos of 'commitment' we will be asking students to be committed to their learning by being fully prepared. We appreciate your support with this.

FilmMakers club will be returning to your school for the Autumn Term 2023. EVERY WEDNESDAY 3.05PM - 4.10PM for a 12-week term. Starting 13th September 2023. What do we do? We focus on building confidence, being creative, making memories & building new friendships! We work with a HD Camera, Green Screens, Clapperboard. The children are fully involved in the story planning, script writing, completing story board templates prior to filming. We plan costumes, the set and any props that are needed for filming. Actual Filming is done by the children with the guidance of Gill. Each child will learn the role of Film Director ensuring filming runs smoothly & everyone is where they should be. Children also learn the role of Clapperboard operator, a key role in any film ensuring the scene is labelled and numbered at every take which assists with the editing process. Children also take on the role of Camera operator. At the end of this club, your child will have been part of a fantastic, fun, creative and inspiring experience. From their very 1st written word in a script to performing the scenes with their friends. All the footage is then taken away and fully edited and on completion you will get a copy of your Childs work to enjoy with Family and Friends.
