What are our snow procedures?

Please see attached to this newsletter our snow procedures, along with a consent form link to complete.

If your child lives in Buntingford and is KS2, [Year 5 or Year 6] please be aware we cannot release your child from school without a designated person to collect them. Please confirm the name of the designated person[s] permitted to collect your child from school. If your KS2 child has an older sibling in KS3, please indicate that you are happy for both of them to go home together.

If your child lives in Buntingford and is KS3 [Year 7 or Year 8] and you are happy for your child to be released from school, without adult supervision, please give permission for your child to walk home and confirm they have a key to get in. Please indicate if you wish your child to wait for your designated person[s] to collect them from school. Please be aware we cannot release your child from school without written parental consent. Buses maybe early if snow is forecast.

Mental Health Focus Week

This half term, we are trying a *focus* for each week. This week's focus is Mental Health. Next week will be attendance. Hertfordshire has once again focused on its annual campaign to make sure students talk when they have a worry or concern.

Attached with this newsletter are the following information leaflets from the Just Talk Campaign that are well worth a look:

- Just talk basic advice for parents, with a particular focus on boys.
- An online safety guide to help your child stay safe and informed online.
- Guidance on online gaming for neuro diverse children, however, I would recommend this for all.

Please remember that as a school, students are regularly supported and encouraged that it is "ok not to be ok, but it is really important to tell someone." The morning PowerPoints in registration and Life Skills schemes of work help them to think about their wellbeing, so that they are able to notice when not ok and once noticed to seek help. Children's Wellbeing Practitioners Service

The Children's Wellbeing Practitioner (CWP) training programme was driven by Health Education England as a response to ensure that children, young people and their parents/carers have access to evidence based preventative and early intervention support for common emotional wellbeing and mental health difficulties. The aim of the HCT Children's Wellbeing Practitioners is to ensure that children and young people can easily access evidence-based support, early in the development of the problem through workshops, groups and 1-1 interventions. Food and Nutrition – All Years

I am looking forward to catching up with cooking this week and hope you are looking forward to creating some wonderful dishes too!

The Fish Heroes Project invited schools across the UK to bid for fresh, sustainably sourced mussels for pupils to learn about and how to cook them – expanding their culinary horizons. Out of all the applications, only 200 schools in the UK were eligible for the free produce. Our bid was successful, and we will be receiving our fresh, Grade A shellfish w/c 2 December. I am hoping the delivery date allows both Year 7 and 8 to experience this fantastic resource which is grown just off our coastline. More info to follow.

Year 5: 5B, 5C and 5D please make sure you bring in your design <u>and</u> your ingredients for your pizza projects. Please remember the design is the most important part of the project. As mentioned on Satchel 1 and in class, if the design is not brought in you will not be allowed to cook - the design is more important than the practical this week. 5A we will be looking at creating your design on Wednesday and will only be cooking 04/12.

If you are concerned your fresh ingredients won't last until next week, pop them in the freezer - veggies too and we will use them from frozen. Please do put them into watertight containers to bring into school as they will start defrosting.

*All ingredient requirements are on Satchel 1. Please remember that if your child has an allergy/intolerance or food preference to change an item, you can send that in as we want pupils to enjoy their own cooking creations.

ALL INGREDIENTS to be named and dropped off first thing on the day of your practical outside the Food Room. <u>No shopping bags</u> are allowed in the fridge, so please label all ingredients.

*Please send in only the required amount of ingredients - there is only 1 fridge in the Food Room and as we have 2 classes cooking on the same day, space is very limited.

Year 8: Healthy Eating Projects were due last lesson. If you still haven't handed it in, please bring it to your next lesson. This project makes up a large proportion of the Food theory mark going up to

Freman. Unfortunately, you will not be able to take part in the next practical if your project is not handed in.
