Drinks in school

Phone calls home

The volume of phone calls home for forgotten items has increased significantly. Please ensure your child has everything prepared for the next day's lessons the night before.

We understand that it is not always practical for you to bring in items for PE, food tech ingredients and/or correct shoes. Not having the correct items may result in your child/children wearing spare PE kit or not being able to take part in food tech lessons.

KS3 Scientific calculators

Many students have now purchased a calculator and we are using them regularly in maths lessons. We would like to begin using more of the functions, but we are unable to do this until all pupils have a scientific calculator in school with them. In line with other schools, your son/daughter will need a scientific calculator for their lessons, they will be able to use this same calculator at Freman College, where it is also a requirement for the curriculum.

The cost of buying a calculator from the school is £8.32, which is a reduced price. To purchase a calculator, payment can be made via the school Gateway. If your child is PP and this cost will cause you financial difficulty, please email s.marler@edwinstree.herts.sch.uk
