Y5 Foundation and Science evening

This re-arranged evening will take place on Thursday 8th June from 5pm to 7pm. No booking required. We really encourage you to bring your child so they can show you their books and the learning journey they have been on since joining us in September.

Year 6 Science

Over the last fortnight I have had the pleasure of joining the year 6 classes for their lamb's heart dissection. It was amazing to see the pupils learning with such respect, determination and working scientific skills.

Year 7 Science

From after half term, 1 science lesson each week will be based around outdoor learning and the pond area. For these sessions it is a good idea for the pupils to have some old, spare clothes in school and some sturdy footwear. These should be items that are okay to get muddy and messy.

It will also give them some ownership of the pond area and allow them to be part of its journey. After speaking to the students, they are very keen to go to the seaside and when we look at costings compared to theatre trips etc, this seems the most reasonable price for a day out in the Summer. We are therefore looking to take them on the 26th of June to Felixstowe. Information and a letter will come out early on our return from half term and we will run the payment window for as long as we can up until the 23rd of June. The cost of the trip will be £25.50.
