What changes are being introduced to the students' toilets in the Summer?

IF I have a SEND need, who can I talk to in school and seek advice from?

Our SEND team is divided into different areas, these include:

Our **Sunrise room** — led by Mrs Bailey, where students who are at risk of school-based avoidance are nurtured. Our **Pupil power unit** led by Ms Arnold, who focuses on interventions for Pupils who need extra support in and out of the classroom and our **Wellbeing Hub** led by Ms Harris and supported by Ms Surrey, this is where the main interventions for well being take place.

Next term Mrs Carter returns from maternity leave, and she will be taking on the lead SEND enquiries alongside Mrs Gant while we wait for the return of Ms Campany in September. Her specialism is Autism.

It is this team that leads the provision for SEND in the school. If you have an enquiry, please use the SEND email address of — you will receive a reply from us, letting you know which member of the team is dealing with the enquiry. We log and track all enquiries, so as not to lose anything, but if you don't here from us, please email again. Since Covid the demands for SEND nationally have peaked at a time when budgets are shrinking.
