Attendance Focus – November 2024

This week our newsletter focus item is on school attendance. We hope that you find the attached information informative. Meet the team:

- **Mrs Gant** is the Headteacher of Edwinstree school and she is also part of the attendance team. Mrs Gant attends attendance meetings, conducts meetings with parents and supports students who might be struggling with attendance.
- **Mrs Heywood** is the attendance lead. She chairs the attendance meetings, meets with the local authority Attendance Officer and oversees the processes in school.
- **Ms Harris** is the schools Mental Health lead. Ms Harris helps families overcome barriers to good school attendance and works closely with students to support them too.
- Mrs Wagstaff organises and processes the day-to-day attendance registers. She is the lovely voice that you hear on the end of the phone when you call the school to notify an absences.
- **Mrs Marler** is our school nurturer! She is known throughout the school community as someone who is warm and has a natural ability to connect with students. She conducts regular check-ins with students who need a little gentle encouragement and praises them often.

What are our snow procedures?

Please see attached to this newsletter our snow procedures, along with a consent form link to complete.

If your child lives in Buntingford and is KS2, [Year 5 or Year 6] please be aware we cannot release your child from school without a designated person to collect them. Please confirm the name of the designated person[s] permitted to collect your child from school. If your KS2 child has an older sibling in KS3, please indicate that you are happy for both of them to go home together.

If your child lives in Buntingford and is KS3 [Year 7 or Year 8] and you are happy for your child to be released from school, without adult supervision, please give permission for your child to walk home and confirm they have a key to get in. Please indicate if you wish your child to wait for your designated person[s] to collect them from school. Please be aware we cannot release your child from school without written parental consent. Buses maybe early if snow is forecast.

Year 6 Science – next week

Our current topic in science is all about the circulatory system.

As part of this, the children have been learning about the function of the heart. We are looking at lots of diagrams, some film clips and have practised explaining the purpose and processes that happen within our circulatory system. To enrich the learning further we are able to complete a practical where the children dissect a pig's heart. This is often a highlight of the Year 6 Science curriculum. Looking at diagrams and pictures is great but the opportunity to hold a heart and see the way the 4 chambers are linked so they can receive and send blood, deepens the children's understanding. The teachers will demonstrate the dissection first, to ensure that the pupils know what they are looking at. Prior to the practical we also discuss the respect needed around dissection and how the opportunity to complete this is a privilege.
