## Year 5 Felixstowe Visit

We are looking to offer your child a visit to the beach and seaside town of Felixstowe. Year 5 will be travelling on **Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2023**. They will leave school at 9am and should arrive in Felixstowe at 10.45am at the latest. They will return from Felixstowe at 3pm and will arrive back at school by 5.30pm.

The purpose of the trip is carry out observation and field work on the transfer of materials/sediment along the beach which is part of their current scheme of work. We also hope to provide joy for a group of students who have missed out on a lot in the last few years and who would benefit from making memories and spending time with each other. We are also supporting students to communicate and have fun together without their mobile devices, so will ask Students to leave them at home. A small disposable camera and/or device to take photo's is appropriate to record their memories, however they bring these at their own risk.

The Cost of the trip is **£22.50 per student and this will need to be paid to the school by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May 2022**. Payment is to be made via the School Gateway App. Alternative travel arrangements home will need to be made for those who use school transport.

Students will be shown the one- mile strip of beach, which will offer an area for crabbing, paddling under supervision and various games activities which we will organise, cricket in the dunes, areas for football, sandcastle making, kite flying, an extensive park, a small fair ground with rides and a pier with all the slot machines you would expect from a seaside beach area. Staff and parent volunteers will be positioned at various points along the beach in order to support and care for the students during the day, and all students will meet their tutor for lunch.

Students will be outside all day, so keeping an eye on the forecast will be important. Come rain or shine we will be on the beach! We do not require students to wear uniform.

We would recommend the following:

- A waterproof jacket and/or clothing if the forecast is poor.
- A packed lunch and lots of drinks if it is hot. (no glass bottles or sweets)
- Money for an ice cream and a drink.
- Sun cream, a hat and sunglasses.
- A swimming costume and towel optional.
- If your child has a bucket and spade, and/or beach ball, they can bring these (named).
- Any medication [including travel sickness tablets] clearly labelled with their name to be handed to the office prior to the visit.

Spending money is not necessary, as there are enough free activities for students to participate in, so money for an ice cream would be all they need. However, if you choose to send your child with spending money we suggest a maximum of £20.00. The school will provide crabbing lines and materials, sporting equipment and kites.
